Constitutional Amendments

- **#1 State Planning and Budget Process** (Establishes a Joint legislative Budget Commission and Government Efficiency Task force)
- #3 Requiring Broader Public support for Constitutional Amendments or Revisions (Requiring that any proposed amendment or revision to the state constitution be adopted by 60% of those voters who participate in the vote instead of 51%)
- #4 Protect People, especially Youth from Addiction, Disease, and other Health Hazards of Using Tobacco. (Requiring that some of the tobacco settlement money be used for prevention and educational purposes, requiring one third be used for advertisements)
- **#6 Increase Homestead Exemption for Low Income Seniors** (Changes the Homestead exemption amount from \$25,000.00 to \$50,000.00 for senior citizens over the age of 65 and with incomes lower than \$20,000.00 annually.)
- #7 Permanantly Disabled Veterans Discount on Homestead Ad Valorem (Provides a discount on Ad Valorem taxes to disabled veterans 65 and older. Disability must have been combat related. Veteran must have entered the service as a Florida Resident and have been honorably discharged.)
- **#8 Eminate Domain** (Prohibiting the taking of Private Property by Eminate Domain, allowing for an exception of a three fifths vote of the Legislature.)

(Note Amendments #2 and #5 were removed from the Ballot)
