### List Of Sponsored Ordinances and Resolutions (Updated Through June 2012)

At the April 11<sup>th</sup>, 2007 town council meeting, then Vice Mayor Ed MacDougall suggested that ordinances and resolutions placed on the agenda should name the council member who proposed the item. Prior to this date, ordinances were placed on the agenda without note as to who brought forth the item.

On the following pages are the names of council members and the items they sponsored listed in the agendas beginning with the May, 2007 meeting. Not all items listed were passed by the town council. Ordinances and Resolutions, not sponsored by members of the town council are not listed.

An item listed as an "Add on item" was placed on the agenda at the last minute with little opportunity for public scrutiny.

The most recent items are listed first. For example, items sponsored in December of any year will be at the top of the list of items for that year, with January items listed last.

The items listed were compiled by looking through the meeting agendas. While we believe the information is complete and accurate, it is possible that we unintentionally missed something.
